Learning about our names!

In Genesis 17 we learn about God giving Sarai the new name of Sarah and blessing her, and in Genesis 21 when Isaac is born we also learn about the meaning of his name. It's time to learn about your name!

Here are some questions you might talk about with your family as you learn about your name and their names!

- 1. Why were you given your name? (perhaps there is a special story your family remembers from the time when they named you)
- 2. What does your name mean?
- 3. Does your name have different meanings in different languages? (see if you can do some research to answer this question!)
- 4. Are there any other ways to spell your name?
- 5. Don't forget to ask about your middle name if you have one!
- 6. Is there any history or story behind your last name?

Creating Name Art

- 1. Be proud of the name you have been given! Create a picture that focusses on your name you might want to use bubble letters, bright colours or other fancy writing to make your name stand out!
- 2. Create an acrostic poem using your name. To do this write out you name and use each letter in your name to think of a word that describes who you are (see below for an example with the name Sarah)



Looking at the Stars!

Although Sarah was getting older and older in Genesis 15 God promised that Sarah and Abraham would have as many descendants as there were stars in the sky. Even though Sarah had to wait for this to happen and it was hard at times, she trusted in God.

With your parents go outside, or look through a window and see how many stars you can see:

- You can stargaze together in the evening or even very early morning
- Can you count the stars? Imagine how many more stars there are that we can't see or count!
- If you or your family know any constellations see if you can find those in the sky
- What else do you see in the sky?
- Some tools that might help your stargazing are binoculars and/or a telescope (even ones that you make!)

<u>Materials</u>


- Black paper
