Family Activities:

As you take part in these activities together feel free to send Roshni pictures of what you created and your time together. With your permission Roshni will share these pictures with our Redeemer community as another way to help us stay connected.

Activity 1: Setting the Scene Craft

Our scriptures describe the scene that Deborah used to hold court in. On page 2 you will find a craft to create this scene in your own home.

Activity 2: Leadership Games & Questions

Deborah was a leader in the bible and that takes a lot of bravery and other skills that we will speak about during church school. On page 3 you will find some leadership games & questions your family can do together to bring out the leader in all of you!

Activity 3: Colouring & Activity Sheets

On pages 4-8 feel free to print and complete/colour these activity sheets.

Setting the Scene

In Judges 4.4 we learn about Deborah who was a judge over Israel. Deborah used to sit under palms in a hill country as she wisely helped the people of Israel solve their problems.

To create the scene of Deborah for yourself follow the instructions below:

<u>Materials:</u>

- Empty paper towel or toilet paper rolls
- Green & brown construction paper (see directions below for some other options)
- Scissors
- Glue or Tape

Directions:

- Take your empty paper towel or toilet paper roll and cover it in brown paper using glue or tape. (If it is already brown you can leave it, or if you don't have brown paper you can colour directly onto the roll to make it brown)
- 2. Cut out palm leaves on green paper. You can create your own leaves or use the template on the link below (You can also cut out your leaves on white paper and colour them green).
- 3. Create as many leaves as you like!
- 4. Glue or tape the end of the leaves to the truck (the roll)

You now have your palm tree- just like the one Deborah used to hold court under. Create as many palm trees as you like! You can also create a figure to be Deborah and other figures to be different people of Israel so that you can act out Deborah helping them.



Leadership Games & Questions

Deborah was a strong and brave leader. Sometimes it's very hard to be a leader, but we like Deborah can all be leaders in our homes, schools, churches and communities. Below are some leadership games you can play together as a family to bring out the leader in you!

Remember it's important to take turns being the leader & listener in these games, because an important part about being a leader is listening!

The Blindfold Game

- You will need 2 people and a blindfold for this game
- Choose one person to be the leader and one person to be blindfolded
- It is then up to the leader to guide the blindfolded person across the room
- The leader should practice speaking in ways that are clear and easy to understand
- If you like you can time yourselves to see how long this takes, and then keep practicing to improve your time!

<u>The Cup Game</u>

- You will need 3 people and a plastic cup for this game
- Choose one person to be the leader. The other two people stand facing each other with a plastic cup on the floor between them
- The leader should call out simple commands such as 'stand on one foot' or 'touch your elbow', that the other two players have to follow as fast as they can
- When the leader says "Cup" the other players have to grab the cup as quick as they can!
- The person holding the cup becomes the new leader for the next round

The Building Game

- You will need Lego, blocks or anything else you can build with for this game
- Choose one person to be the first builder
- For one minute the builder starts to build a castle out of your building materials, BUT the builder cannot talk
- After 1 minute switch the builder to another person and have them continue the work of the first builder
- After everyone playing has had 2 chances to be the builder see what you have created!

- 3. Who are some of the leaders in your life?
- 4. How can you be a leader in your home and family?
- 5. How can you be a leader in your community?
- 6. How can you be a leader in the Church?
