Making Palm Crosses & Your Own Palms!

Materials:

- A long strip of paper (ideally green paper if you have it!)

Directions:

Making a palm cross can take some patience, some help, and a few attempts. But have fun and do your best! Below are a couple of recourses that might help you make your own palm cross out of paper. If you don't find these resources helpful you can search some online- there are many different ways and demonstrations to learn from!

OR make some palm branches from your own PALMS!

Materials:

- Paper (green or whatever you have available)
- Glue or tape or a stapler
- A craft stick or straw (if you have one)

Directions:

1. Trace your hand on a piece of paper (green paper is ideal - you could always colour your white paper green!) - do this 3-4 times
2. Cut out the hands you have traced
3. Glue or tape the cut-out hands to a craft stick or straw (if you don't have a stick just glue/tape/staple the hands together)
4. Wave your palms proudly as you parade today! (there are also palms you can colour and cut out on pg. 4)



Have a Palm Sunday Parade!

I am glad you will be joining us for a parade when we 'Zoom into Church School' and you can wave your palms at the Redeemer Service at 10:30am- but below are some suggestions if you and your family want to have your own palm Sunday parade!

Create a parade route:

The parade route can be through different rooms in your house or perhaps outside on the sidewalk if you can. Map out a route together and then set out!

What you need:

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, people laid out their cloaks on the ground. Check if you have any coats, blankets or material you can lay out on the ground for your parade route!

Carry your palm branches, crosses, and any other noisemakers or parade decorations you may have at home (or maybe even some you crafted!)


What to say:

During Jesus' entry into Jerusalem people shouted "*Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!*" Put yourself in the scene and shout these same words, or play the song from the video on the first page of this package.

(Mark 11)


As Jesus rode the donkey through Jerusalem, people shouted, "Hosanna."
