Family Activities:

As you take part in these activities together feel free to send Roshni pictures of what you created and your time together. With your permission Roshni will share these pictures with our Redeemer community as another way to help us stay connected.

Activity 1: Gift Giving

Mary Magdalene is thought to have anointed Jesus with perfume as a way to show how much she valued and cared for him. On **page 2** you will find a 'perfume' gift you can make for your loved ones in the same way that Mary shared her gift with Jesus!

Activity 2: The world of our heroes

The female heroes we have been learning about in the bible lived very different lives from women today, and even in our recent history. On **page 3** you can find some ways to help your family explore the lives of some of your favourite female heroes and the world around them!

Activity 3: Colouring & Activity Sheets

Gift Giving

Below is gift making activity that reminds us of the gift that Mary Magdalene is believed to have shared with Jesus. Below are directions for you to make a homemade 'perfume'. Share your gift with someone you value as a way to show them you appreciate them and want to take care of them!

What you Need:

- A bowl (for mixing your 'perfume' ingredients in)
- A clear jar or other type of container to be your 'perfume' bottle
- A funnel, sieve or strainer
- Any herbs and/or flower petals
- Pre-cut citrus fruits
- Water
- Food colouring (optional)
- Glitter (optional)
- Decorations for your 'perfume' bottle

Directions

1. Cut the leaves of herbs or collect petals from flowers. The herbs and petals can then be crushed in your hands to help release the scents. Place the crushed herbs and petals in your bowl
2. Squeeze the citrus fruit into your bowl and then place the piece of fruit you have squeezed into the bowl as well
3. Fill your bowl with water (almost to the top). If you like you can also add food colouring at this time or glitter
4. Let your mixture sit in the bowl for around 30 minutes
5. Decorate your 'perfume' jar using the supplies you have at home anyway you like
6. Using your funnel/sieve/ strainer pour the contents of your bowl into your 'perfume' jar and seal it.

Enjoy the scent you have created and be sure to gift it to someone who will enjoy it too! (be sure to give them the 'perfume' soon, because this type of 'perfume' is not meant to last forever!)



Learning about the world of our heroes

So far we have learned about the lives of Sarah, Deborah, Ruth, and Mary Magdalene. There are many more female heroes in the bible that we can learn about, and even more female heroes throughout the rest of history. When learning about anyone in the past or present it is important to also learn about the world in which they lived in because it may have looked very different from the world we live in now. This can help us understand our heroes even more!

Below are some questions you can explore as a family to learn about the world of some of your favourite female heroes:

1. Pick 3 different female heroes from 3 different times in the world (one might be from the bible, one might be from another generation or decade, and one can be a hero who is alive today).
2. Why are the 3 women you picked heroes?
3. Describe what the world would have been like for these three women when they would have been alive? (you might need to do some research for this!)
4. For each of your heroes, why might it have been difficult to be a woman in the time they were alive?
5. For each of your heroes, why might it have been great to be a woman in the time they were alive?
6. For each of your heroes, how could other people in the world have supported them during the time they were alive and who were some of the people that did support them?
