Activity 1: Tent Makers

Priscilla, her husband Aquila and her friend Paul worked as tent makers in the city of Corinth. On **page 2** you will find suggestions for making your own tent with your family.

Tent Makers

Priscilla was a tent maker in the city of Corinth and did this with her husband Aquila and eventually her friend Paul. Tent making was a useful trade for Priscilla to know because many people lived in tents while travelling. However, in addition to being a tent maker Priscilla would also preach and tell people about Jesus!

Below are some materials you can use to make your own tent in your home or an outdoor space (if you already own a tent maybe you could also put that up!)

Materials:

- Sheets
- Blankets
- Pillows
- Chairs
- Decorations
- Anything you think would be helpful!

Directions:

1. Using the materials, you have at home create your own tent with other members of your family (remember Priscilla worked with others to make tents and to teach people about God - so make sure you work as a team!)
2. Once you have created your tent use it as a space to spend some quiet time in and enjoy!
3. Sharing the Good News: When Priscilla wasn't making tents, she was telling people about Jesus and the love of God. In your tent take turns sharing what you believe about God. You can also retell your favourite bible story or say a prayer together!



Travelling Where God Leads Us

Priscilla travelled to share the Good News of Christ with many people. Travel for her would have looked very different from jumping in a car or a plane like we might today. Imagine how Priscilla might have prepared to travel and how the journeys to faraway places might have been for her.

Below are some ways your family can play and explore travel!

A travelling game to try at home:

What you need

1. A small stack of paper
2. Tape

How to Play:

- In teams try to cross the sea (the floor) by making a bridge with paper and tape

Rules:

- Every member of the team must be on a paper (the bridge) at all times
- The pieces of paper that make up the bridge must be connected with tape

Feel free to colour and decorate your bridge after you have created it!


