R – resourceful

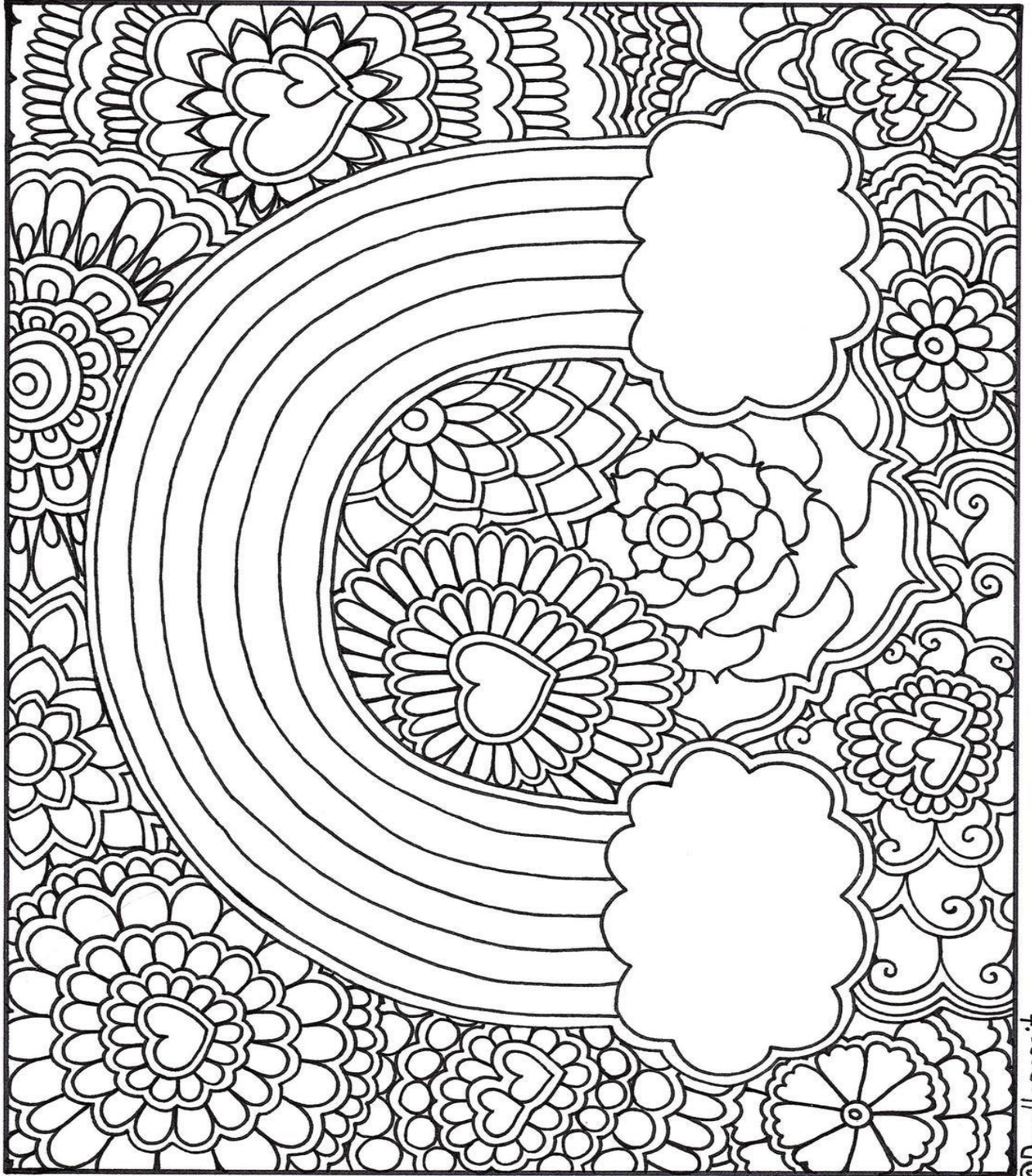
Y – yellow
