
Children in Worship

Wear a mask



The sessions are a wonderful chance to get to know one another better and to share questions, concerns, and insights about our faith and how we live it.




Reading and Praying the Psalms Together

Not only have we met this match, but this challenge has brought us over the \$20,000 mark.


Stay tuned for a full update once we have the details from the Easter offertory tally of designated gifts to the campaign. The team thanks you for your generosity!
