# A Lutheran–Anglican–Moravian Full Communion Cycle of Prayer

*Advent 1, 2024 to the Reign of Christ, 2025*

## Introduction

Welcome to the 2024-2025 Lutheran-Anglican-Moravian Full Communion Cycle of Prayer! This Cycle of Prayer was prepared by the Lutheran-Anglican-Moravian Commission for use in Canadian congregations, parishes, and communities, including for Sunday liturgies throughout the year.

The document is a bit of an experiment. While our three traditions share a calling to pray for the whole world, including our Christian siblings in churches closely linked to our own, there are variations in how this calling is lived out. The use of a cycle of prayer in the Moravian tradition is less common than in the Anglican and Lutheran traditions. There are also variations in size, jurisdictional regions, and structures of leadership among our three denominations that complicate the weaving together of balanced document.
