



Psalm 99



- (1) Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among those who call upon his name,
- (2) they called upon the Lord, and he answered them.
- (3) He spoke to them out of the pillar of cloud;
- (4) they kept his testimonies and the decree that he gave them. **Refrain.**

- (1) "O Lord our God, you answered them indeed;
- (2) you were a God who forgave them, yet punished them for their evil deeds."
- (3) Proclaim the greatness of the Lord our God and worship him upon his holy hill;
- (4) for the Lord our God is the Holy One. **Refrain.**
