Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlined word or syllable.



- (1) To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul;
- (1) my God, I put my <u>trust</u> in you;
- (2) let me not be humiliated, nor let my enemies triumph over me.
- (3) Let none who look to you be put to shame;
- (4) let the treacherous be disappointed in their schemes. Refrain.
- (1) Show me your ways, O Lord,
- (2) and teach me your paths.
- (3) Lead me in your truth and teach me,
- (3) for you are the God of my <u>sal</u>vation;
- (4) in you have I trusted all the <u>day</u> long. *Refrain*.
- (1) Remember, O Lord, your compassion and love,
- (2) for they are from everlasting.
- (3) Remember not the sins of my youth and my <u>transgressions</u>;
- (3) remember me according to your love
- (4) and for the sake of your goodness, O Lord. *Refrain*.

Gracious and upright <u>is</u> the Lord; therefore he teaches sinners in <u>his</u> way. He guides the humble in <u>do</u>ing right and teaches his way to <u>the</u> lowly. *Refrain*.
