Introduction

Prove me, O Lord. I walk in faith-ful-ness to you.

- (1) Vindicate me, O Lord, for I have walked with integrity,
(1) and I have trusted in the lord without wavering.
(2) Prove me, O Lord, and try me;
(2) test my heart and mind.
(3) For your steadfast love is before my eyes,
(4) and I walk in faithfulness to you. **R.**

- (1) I do not sit with the worthless,
(2) nor do I consort with hypocrites;
(3) I hate the company of evildoers,
(4) and will not sit with the wicked. **R.**

- (1) I wash my hands in innocence, and go around your altar, O Lord,
(2) singing aloud a song of thanksgiving, and telling all your wondrous deeds.
(3) O Lord, I love the house in which you dwell,
(4) and the place where your glory abides. **R.**
