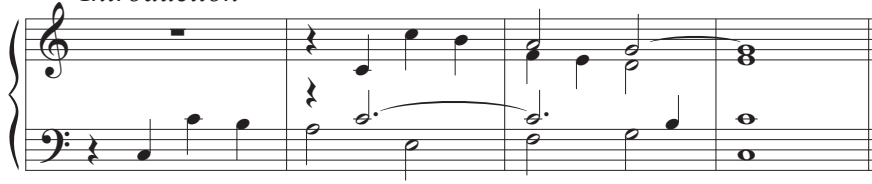


Psalm 93, Reign of Christ
