Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlined word or syllable.



- (1) God is enthroned upon the <u>che</u>rubim;
- (2) let the earth shake and its people tremble.
- (1) Our God is great in  $\underline{Zi}$ on;
- (2) and high above <u>all</u> peoples.
- (3) Let them confess the Name which is great and awesome,
- (4) Our God is the Holy One. **R.**
- (1) "O Mighty Sovereign, lover of justice, you have established equity;
- (2) you have executed justice and righteousness <u>in</u> Jacob."
- (3) Proclaim the greatness of our God, bow down  $\underline{in}$  worship:
- (4) You, God, are the Holy One. R.
- (1) Moses and Aaron among your priests, and Samuel among those who call upon your name,
- (2) they called upon you and you answered them.
- (3) You spoke to them out of the pillar of cloud,
- (4) they kept your testimonies and the decrees that you gave them.  $\mathbf{R}$ .
- (1) "O God, you answered them indeed;
- (2) you were a God who forgave them, yet punished them for their evil deeds."
- (3) Proclaim God's greatness; worship upon the holy hill;
- (4) for God is the Holy One.  $\mathbf{R}$ .
