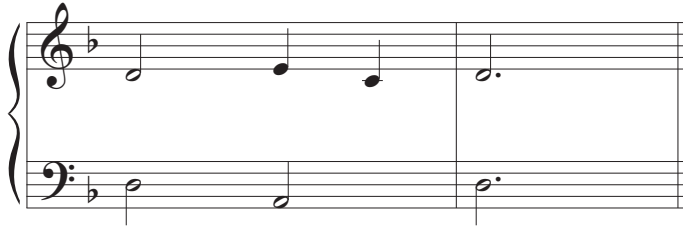


# Psalm 36.5-11
