- (3) Wealth and riches will be in their house, and their righteousness will last <u>for</u> ever.

- (4) Light shines in the darkness for the upright; the righteous are merciful and <u>full</u> of compassion. *R*.
- (1) It is good for them to be generous in lending and to manage their af<u>fairs</u> with justice.
- (2) For they will never be shaken; the righteous will be kept in everlasting remembrance.
- (3) They will not be afraid of any evil rumours; their heart is right; they put their trust in God.
- (4) Their heart is established and will not shrink, until they see their desire <u>upon</u> their enemies. *R*.
- (1) They have given freely to the poor, and their righteousness stands <u>fast</u> for ever;
- (2) they will hold up their <u>head</u> with honour.
- (3) The wicked will see it and <u>be</u> angry;
- (4) they will gnash their teeth and pine away; the desires of the <u>wick</u>ed will perish. *R*.
