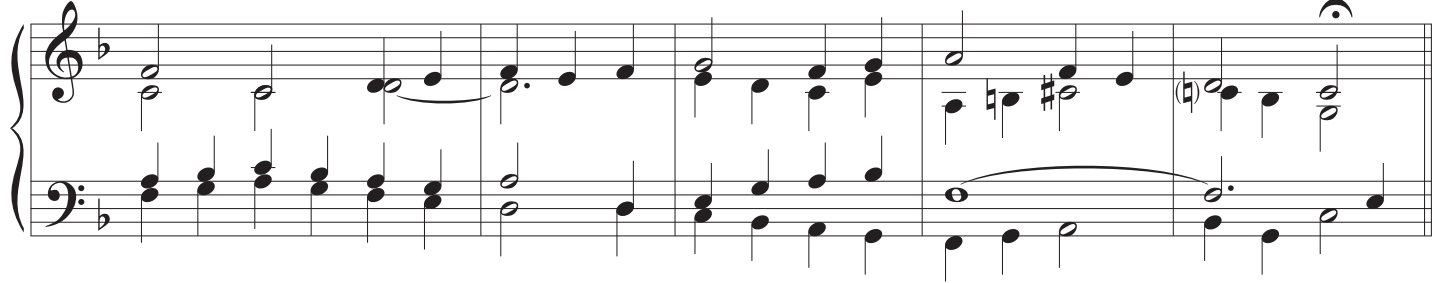

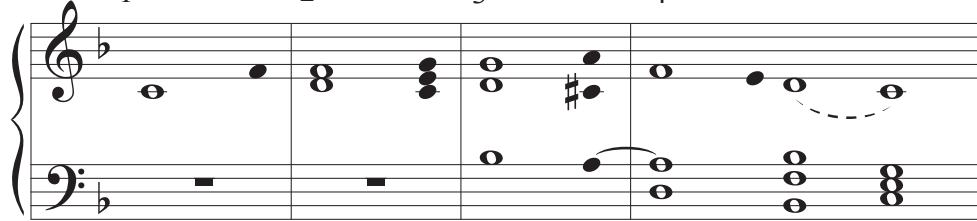


Unison
