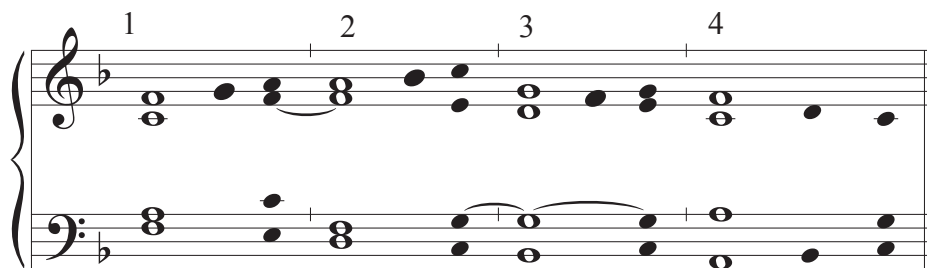
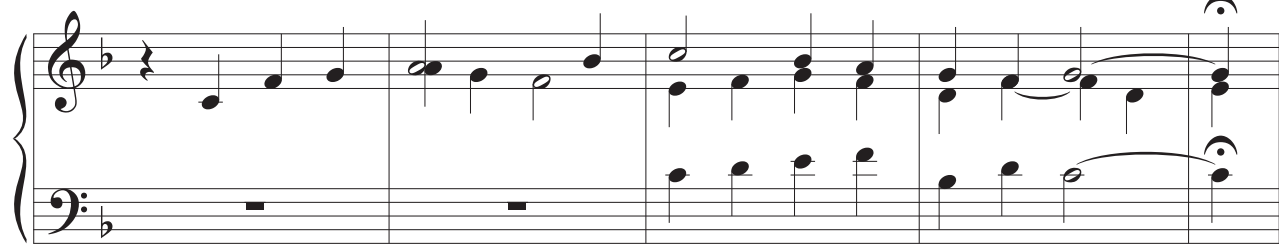


Responsorial Psalm 145:1-5,17-22

Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlined word or syllable.



(1) I will exalt you, O sovereign God, and bless your name for ever and ever.

(2) Every day will I bless you and praise your name for ever and ever.

(3) You are great, O God, and greatly to be praised;

(4) there is no end to your greatness. *Refrain.*

(1) One generation shall praise your works to another

(2) and shall declare your power.

(3) I will ponder the glorious splendour of your majesty

(4) and all your marvellous works. *Refrain.*

(1) You open wide your hand

(2) and satisfy the needs of every living creature.

(3) O God, you are righteous in all your ways

(4) and loving in all your works. *Refrain*

(1) You are near to those who upon you,

(2) to all who call upon you faithfully.

(3) You fulfill the desire of those who fear you,

(4) you hear their cry and help them. *Refrain.*

(1) You preserve all those who love you,

(2) but destroy all the wicked.

(3) My mouth shall speak your praise, O God;

(4) let all flesh bless your holy name for ever and ever. *Refrain.*
