

Psalm 116, Easter 3 1-3,10-17

Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlined word or syllable.







- (1) I love you, O God, because you have heard the voice of my supplication,

- (4) is the death of your <u>ser</u>vants. R.

- (2) you have freed me from my bonds.
- (3) I will offer you the sacrifice of thanks giving
- (4) and call upon your name, O God.
- (1) I will fulfil my vows to you, O God,
- (2) in the presence of all <u>your</u> people.
- (3) In the courts of <u>God's</u> house,
- (3) in the midst of <u>Je</u>rusalem.
