- (4) the right hand of the Mighty One has triumphed!" **R.**

- (1) I shall not die, but live,
- (2) and declare the works of of God.
- (3) God has punished me sorely,
- (4) but did not hand me over to to death. **R.**

- (1) Open for me the gates of of righteousness;
- (2) I will enter them; I will offer thanks to God.
- (3) "This is the gate of the Holy One;
- (4) those who are righteous may enter." **R.**

- (1) I will give thanks to you, for you answered me
- (2) and have become my salvation.
- (3) The same stone which the builders rejected
- (4) has become the chief cornerstone. **R.**

- (1) This is God's doing,
- (2) and it is marvellous in our eyes.
- (3) On this day our God has acted;
- (4) we will rejoice and be glad in it. **R.**
