- (1) Let all peoples bless you, O God;
- (2) make the voice of your praise resound.
- (3) You hold our souls in life,
- (4) and will not allow our feet to slip. **R.**

- (1) For you, O God, have proved us;
- (2) you have tried us just as silver is tried.
- (1) You brought us into the snare;
- (2) you laid heavy burdens upon our backs.
- (3) You let enemies ride over our heads;
- (3) we went through fire and water;
- (4) but you brought us out into a place of refreshment. **R.**

- (1) I will enter your house with burnt-offerings and will pay you my vows,
- (2) which I promised with my lips and spoke with my mouth when I was in trouble.
- (3) I will offer you sacrifices of fat beasts with the smoke of rams;
- (4) I will give you oxen and goats. **R.**

- (1) Let all who fear you come to me,
- (2) and I will tell them what you have done for me.
- (3) I called out to you with my mouth,
- (4) and your praise was on my tongue. **R.**

- (1) If I had found evil in my heart,
- (2) you, God, would not have heard me;
- (1) But in truth you have heard me;
- (2) and have attended to the voice of my prayer.
- (3) Praise to you, O God, you have not rejected my prayer,
- (4) nor withheld your love from me. **R.**
