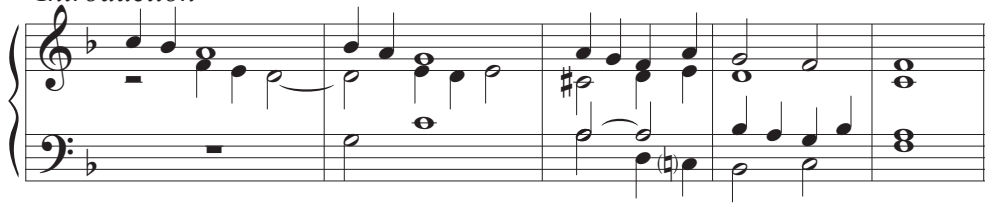


Psalm 128
