## Introduction

*Unison* Turn — to me; save the child of your hand - maid.

- (1) Teach me your way, O God,
- (2) and I will walk in your truth;
- (3) knit my heart to you that I may fear your name.
- (4) I will thank you, O my God, with all my heart,
- (6) and glorify your name for evermore. **R**

- (1) For great is your love toward me;
- (2) you have delivered me from the nethermost Pit.
- (3) The arrogant rise up against me, O God,
- (4) and the violent are gathered to seek my life;
- (6) they have not set you before their eyes. **R**

- (1) But you, O God, are gracious and full of compassion,
- (1) slow to anger, and full of kindness and truth.
- (2) Turn to me and have mercy upon me;
- (3) give your strength to your servant,  
and save the child of your handmaid.
- (4) Show me a sign of your favour,
- (5) so that those who hate me may see it  
and be ashamed;
- (6) because you, O God, have helped me  
and comforted me. **R**
