- (4) with my holy oil have I anointed him. **R.**
- (1) "My hand will hold him fast
- (2) and my arm will make him strong.
- (3) No enemy shall deceive him,
- (4) nor shall the wicked bring him down. \mathbf{R} .
- (1) I will crush his foes before him
- (2) and strike down those who hate him.
- (3) My faithfulness and love shall be with him,
- (4) and he shall be victorious through my name. \mathbf{R} .
- (1) I shall make his dominion extend
- (2) from the Great Sea to the River.
- (3) He will say to me, 'You gave me life,
- (4) my God, you are the rock of \underline{my} salvation." \mathbf{R} .
