

## Psalm 34. V1-8, 19-22

Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlines word or syllable.





- (1) I will bless God at all times;
- (2) my mouth will always be praising my Maker.
- (3) I will glory in the Holy One;
- (4) let the humble hear and rejoice. R.
- (1) Proclain with me the greatness of the <u>Most High</u>;
- (2) let us exhalt God's name forever.
- (3) I sought my God and was answered.
- (4) and delivered from all my terror. R.
- (1) Look upon God and be radiant,
- (2) and let not your faces <u>be</u> ashamed.
- (3) I called in my affliction and was heard
- (4) and saved from all my troubles. **R.**
- (1) Your angel, O God, encompasses those who fear you,
- (2) and will deliver them,
- (3) Taste and see that God is good;
- (4) happy are they who trust in the Holy One. **R.**



- (1) Many are the troubles of <u>the</u> righteous.
- (2) but you will deliver them.
- (3) You will keep safe all their bones:
- (4) not one of them shall be broken. **R.**
- (1) Evil shall slay the wicked,
- (2) and those who hate the righteous will be punished.
- (3) You, God, ransom each faithful servant.
- (4) and none will be punished who trust in you. **R.**
