- (2) Lead me in your truth and teach me,
- (3) for you are the God of my salvation; in you have I trusted all the day long. **R.**

- (1) Remember, O God, your compassion and love, for they are from everlasting.
- (2) Remember not the sins of my youth and my transgressions; remember me according to your love
- (3) and for the sake of your goodness, O God. **R.**

- (1) Gracious are you and upright, O God;
- (2) therefore you teach sinners in your way.
- (1) You guide the humble in doing right and teach your way to the lowly.
- (2) Your paths, O God, are love and faithfulness
- (3) to those who keep your covenant and your testimonies. **R.**
