The Song of Miriam and Moses

Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each verse.

In the psalm-tone the measures are of equal length, but the syllables are to be distributed within each measure according to their natural rhythm. A whole note in the psalm-tone is equal to a half note in the refrain.

This canticle may be accompanied by keyboard or guitar, or the refrain could be accompanied by a keyboard instrument and the verses by guitar. The guitar chords and the keyboard accompianment for the refrain are not compatible. If a keyboard instrument is used for the cerses, the accompianment of the first verse is used for the other verses. In the 4th verse, the first two lines of accompianment are repeated.
