

Responsorial Psalm 1

Introduction. Cantor sings refrain. All repeat refrain. Cantor sings verses. All sing refrain after each group of verses. In the psalm-tone the singer leaves the reciting note on the underlined word or syllable.







Happy are they who have not walked in the counsel <u>of</u> the wicked, nor lingered in the way of sinners, nor sat in the seats of <u>the</u> scornful! Their delight is in your law, \underline{O} God, and they meditate on it day <u>and</u> night. *Refrain*.

They are like trees planted by <u>streams</u> of water, bearing fruit in <u>due</u> season, with leaves that <u>do</u> not wither; everything they do <u>shall</u> prosper. *Refrain*.

It is not so <u>with</u> the wicked; (1) they are like chaff which the wind <u>blows</u> a-way. (1) Therefore the wicked shall not stand upright when judge<u>ment</u> comes, (2) nor the sinner in the council of <u>the</u> righteous. (2) For God knows the way <u>of</u> the righteous, (3) but the way of the wicked <u>is</u> doomed. (4) *Refrain*.
