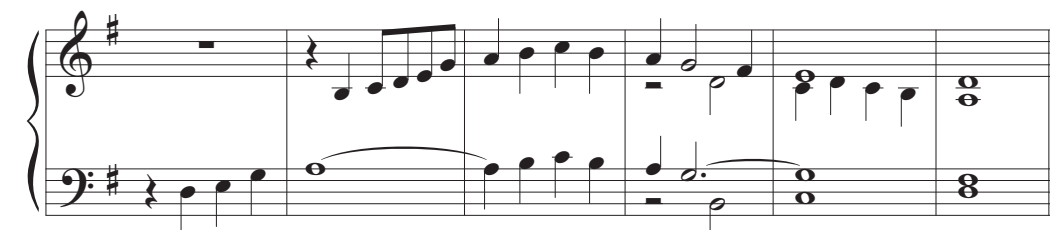


Psalm 133
