- (1) Show me your ways, O God,

(3) Lead me in your truth and teach me,  
(3) for you are the God of my salvation;  
(4) in you have I trusted all the day long. **R.**

- (1) Remember, O God, your compassion and love,  
(2) for they are from everlasting.  
(3) Remember not the sins of my youth and my transgressions;  
(3) remember me according to your love  
(4) and for the sake of your goodness, O God. **R.**

- (1) Gracious are you and upright, O God;  
(2) therefore you teach sinners in your way.  
(1) You guide the humble in doing right  
(2) and teach your way to the lowly.  
(3) Your paths, O God, are love and faithfulness  
(4) to those who keep your covenant and your testimonies. **R.**
