- (1) With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.
- (2) And you will say on that day: "Give thanks to the Lord, call on his name;
- (3) make known his deeds among the nations;
- (4) proclaim that his name is exalted. R.
- (1) Sing praises to the Lord, for he <u>has</u> done gloriously;
- (2) let this be known in all the earth.
- (3) Shout aloud and sing for joy, O royal Zion,
- (4) for great in your midst is the Holy One of Israel." **R.**
